**THE DEADLINE TO APPLY TO REGISTER TO VOTE IN THE GENERAL ELECTION IS OCTOBER 5, 2020.**

**PUBLIC LOGIC & ACCURACY TESTING** of the voting equipment for Early Voting and Election Day use will begin at 1:00 p.m. on Friday, October 9, 2020 at the County Clerk's Office in Berryville.

Beginning October 19, 2020 through November 2, 2020, Carroll County election officials may begin opening the outer envelopes, processing and canvassing absentee voter correspondence and placing the sealed "Absentee Ballot Only" envelopes into a sealed ballot box Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at the Carroll County Courthouse.

The counting of Absentee Ballots may begin on November 3, 2020, at 8:30 a.m. in the Carroll County Courthouse in Berryville.

Results from the General Election will be tallied at the Carroll County Courthouse in Berryville, beginning at 7:30 p.m. on November 3, 2020.

In accordance with the requirements of Ark. Code Ann. § 7-5-202(b), a notice of election workers will be posted as of October 5, 2020 and remain posted until November 2, 2020 at the County Clerk's Office in the Eastern and Western District Courthouses. Any person wishing to file an objection with the County Board of Election Commissioners to disallow any poll worker who is a spouse or related to the 2<sup>nd</sup> degree of consanguinity to any candidate on the ballot, may do so by submitting a written statement requesting the poll worker be disallowed based on your reason. Include the name of the poll worker and the relation to the candidate, the name of the candidate, as well as your name, address, and phone number. You may submit your statement to the Carroll County Clerk's Office within (10) days of the date the notice is posted.
