PROCLAMATION – PUBLIC NOTICE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE 2021 ANNUAL SCHOOL BOARD ELECTION SHALL BE CONDUCTED BY ABSENTEE AND EARLY VOTING ONLY PER RESOLUTIONS PASSED BY THE BERRYVILLE, EUREKA SPRINGS AND GREEN FOREST SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND FILED WITH THE COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTION COMMISSIONERS AND THE CARROLL COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE. THERE ARE NO CONTESTED RACES AND THERE IS NOT AN INCREASE OF THE MILLAGE RATE FOR ANY OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICTS.

The deadline to apply to register to vote for the school election is April 19, 2021.

May 11, 2021 is the last day for the County Clerk to accept an absentee ballot application by mail, fax or email.

**EARLY VOTING** will begin on Tuesday, **MAY 11, 2021** at the Eastern District Courthouse; 210 W Church, Berryville. The last day to early vote is **MAY 17, 2021**. Early voting for the School Election will be available during regular office hours from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. There will be no polling sites open on Election Day, May 18, 2021.

All ADA compliant Accessible Early Voting will be available at the Eastern District Courthouse in Berryville.

**Public Logic and Accuracy Testing** of the voting equipment that is be used in the School Election will begin on **April 30, 2021** at 1:00 p.m. at the County Clerk's Office.

Processing of Absentee and Early Votes may begin on May 18, 2021 8:30 p.m. at the Carroll County Courthouse.

Processing the results for the 2021 School Election will begin at the Eastern District Courthouse in Berryville beginning at 9:00 a.m. on May 18, 2021.

The Carroll County Board of Election Commissioners will meet on Monday, May 24, 2021 at 11:00 a.m. at the Carroll County Clerk's Office for hearings regarding any Provisional Ballots cast in the 2021 School Board Election.

The Carroll County Board of Election Commissioners will meet Monday, May 24, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. at the Carroll County Clerk's Office to begin Certification of the results of the 2021 Annual School Board Election.

In accordance with the requirements of Ark. Code Ann. § 7-5-202(b), a notice of election workers will be posted as of April 26, 2021 and remain posted until May 17th at the County Clerk's Office in the Eastern District Courthouse. Any person wishing to file an objection with the County Board of Election Commissioners to disallow any poll worker who is a spouse or related to the 2<sup>nd</sup> degree of consanguinity to any candidate on the ballot, may do so by submitting a written statement requesting the poll worker be disallowed based on your reason. Include the name of the poll worker and the relation to the candidate, the name of the candidate, as well as your name, address, and phone number. You may submit your statement to the Carroll County Clerk's Office on or before May 5th, 2021 (10 days from this posting).
